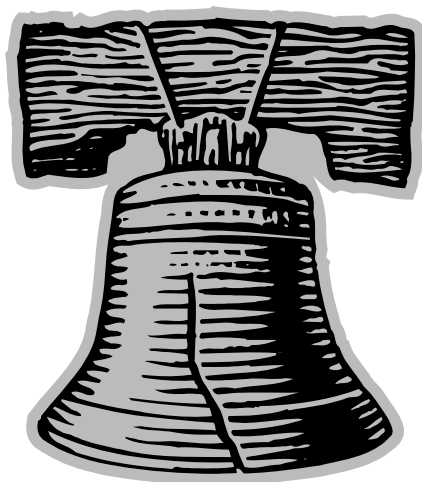

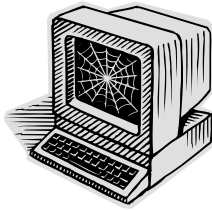

*On Thursday, June 17, the Heath Church Board of Directors met/interviewed **Rev. Henry Watterson** of Winston-Salem, to discuss the possibility of hiring him as part-time Asst. Pastor / Youth Pastor. In that meeting the B. O. D. voted unanimously to present Henry to the Heath Church membership to discuss / vote on his candidacy for a 6 month trial term.
